Green Submission – The Rickert's have submitted a proposal for a GREEN submission for events. Instead of using thumb drives, CD's, paper, move to a "Cloud" submission. The will reduce all paper and e-waste. Could be submitted on PATSA web site. The projects would be submitted 10 days prior and judges could call only those for interviews. Eliminates the need for judges to come to the site, reduce the cost and get better feedback.

Lauren: possibility of submitting things done on-site (On-Demand, PA Digital Video options). Must have reliable feedback that the event was not only received andu able to be open and viewed. Biggest concern for Lauren is getting the judges.

Laura Hummel said that the CRC is looking at green initiatives and will take suggestions for the Photo competition

Chris Miller said part of the problem is an infrastructure thing....the wheels of change turn slowly but... it will come

Laura: Dealing with IT people at various judging sites is a big issue. When going to a hotel or university, IT is apprehensive about letting foreign groups use internet with no restrictions.

Team Reports

• State Officer Team - State Officer Team Report

State Conference Team – Blazer and blue short: only required for Chapter Team but at the state conference, students can wear a white shirt (all team members must be dressed alike). Starting in 2014, nationals will accept just the blue shirt, no blazer for every event. Dennis suggested making something standards for all regions for the regional conferences. Laura said that she talked to advisors personally.

Basile: Working on state conference and the sessions

Hewitt: sending out letters to politicians across the state (56 letters)

<u>Sayoc:</u> membership comm. – creating promotional materials, created new events and sent to CRC (Leadership Strategies group event)

<u>Hunt:</u> helping out with membership comm., drafting an email for chapters to archive events <u>Soundararajan:</u> transitioning away from PA-Post and going to web based articles, dedicating on section to STEMF fields

<u>Sheehan:</u> events at states...sending info to regionals to create teams for ACS, luminairia ceremony at states, chapters do relay for life prior to states (give money) – Mr. Miller explains...chapters can set up teams and raise money but if only one kid wants to do relay, they can join a region team (PATSA team).

Houghton: recording a video for viewing regionals

Pilai: National president – conference planning at nationals, no big changes

<u>Lu:</u> by-law amendment...once passed they will publicize...duties of an office vs. working as a team.

The new amendment would change the officer team number/positions/jobs, etc...voting at states.

Could try this amendment first and if it doesn't work, go back to what it was.

Retention question from CMiller to membership comm: why are chapters leaving, why aren't we holding on to chapters? Sayoc...worked to get new chapters...will look into why this year

State Conference Update:

- -Trophies will be unpacked in order of when they are given
- -Schedule is being put in place...hardly any changes. HS check in first this year and then MS second therefore testing schedule will be changed or flipped.
- -Judges and coordinators agreements will come out after Feb 9th
- -Will the Ziplines be up and running this year?

Dave Zinn asked about health care professionals at the state conference...there is an EMT on Seven Springs staff but if they can't handle it, they will transport to the hospital.,. PATSA needs to make sure there is a rider on our policy to transport students in an emergency. Our Medical packet should be amended to include "Transport a student in our private vehicle to a medical facility". Lauren: We may have to contact a lawyer to check for liability. Brandt: do we have a lawyer to check for accuracy? Miller: 'We live in a litigious society and should look into the language necessary to insure our organization and it's advisors.'

Technology Team- Technology Planning Team Report

• State Officer Application, Completely Online (including PDF and Photo submission) Awards Nominations, Completely Online- Delivered a total electronic officer nomination form.
