## New Business

- [Bulk Exclusion Voting Bylaw Amendment \(Submitted 1/3/16\)](#) –discussed in old business
  - Ask from Ron Shealer to refund late fees because;
    - Live wire mailing had the wrong dates
    - Was not informed at his regional planning meeting
    - It was decided that the money would be refunded (18 were charged but 46 were actually late). We can apply the credit to the state fee. Section 6.04 (a) 2) has been changed and will be posted in the Livewire by the beginning of the school year.
      - Motion: Section 6.04 (a) 2) should be changed to read: CWeaver, 2<sup>nd</sup>: CMiller
      - 2) Affiliation is defined as the chapter has completed all of the membership steps required by National TSA and the standard approval confirmation has been sent to PATSA from National TSA allowing the chapter's PATSA iServices account to be activated. Chapters completing the Affiliation process after December 1st will incur a \$75 late fee to be charged by National TSA at the time of Affiliation or by PATSA prior to participating in Regional Conferences. PATSA may charge this fee to a chapter's Regional Conference Registration.- APPROVED
- Motion: CMiller, 2<sup>nd</sup>:CWeaver: Remove the word 'new' from Section 6.04 (a) 5,6,7&8 - APPROVED
- Activate 2 new committees that oversee National Awards and Candidate approval for National Office chaired by the state advisor. This committee should be called “National Awards and Candidacy Approval Committee”. State Officer advisors, John Bratton and State Advisor should be on this committee.
